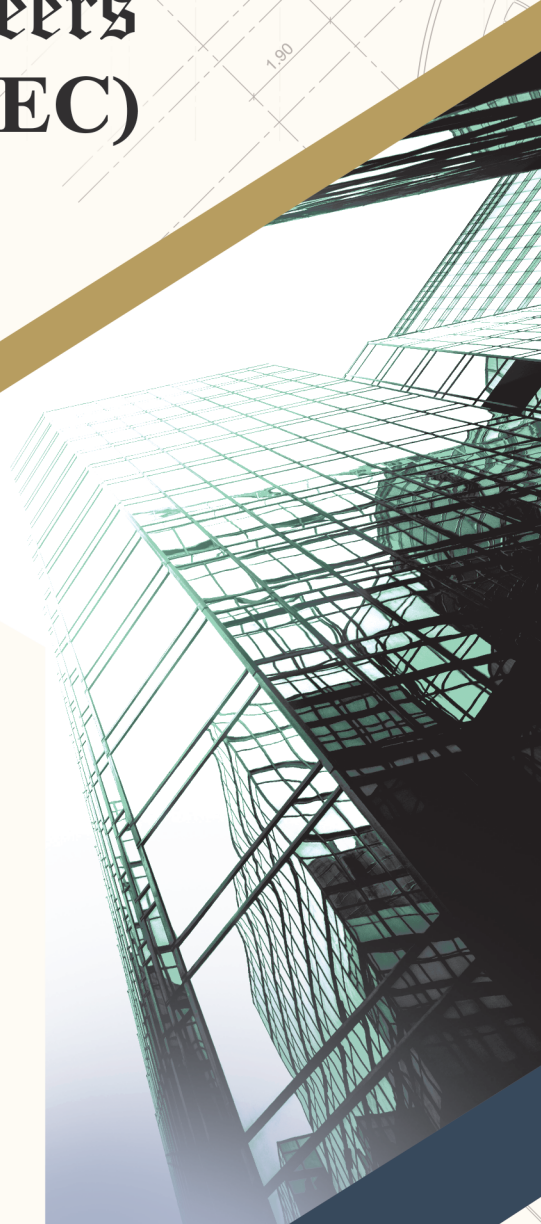

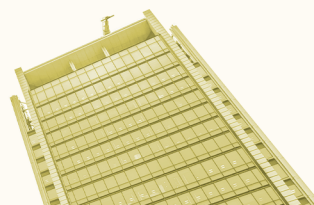
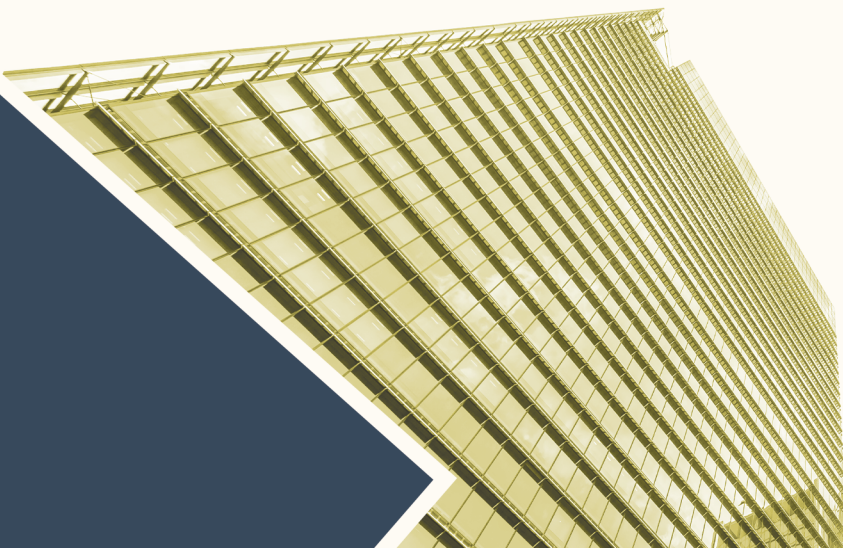


VISION

CLASSES OF MEMBERS

FOUNDER MEMBER

Founder members refers to those persons who have involved in setting up of ICEC Association.

FELLOW MEMBER

Any individual who has minimum three years of industrial or academic experience in Civil Engineering industry can become Fellow Member.

ASSOCIATE MEMBER

Associate Membership is the general membership class of ICEC. Any individual having AICTE/UGC approved graduation in Civil Engineering can become Associate Member.

PRE-ASSOCIATE MEMBER

Civil Engineering Students or any individual who has submitted application for membership after membership submission date will be given Pre-Associate membership status until he/she gains Associate Membership.



AREA OF OPERATION

The area of operation of The Integrated Civil Engineers Council (ICEC), shall be across all states of India except Jammu and Kashmir. ICEC will have multiple Chapters in each state according to the volume of members for operational convenience. All Chapters will be monitored by state committees and the state committees will report to the Core Executive Committee.



MEMBERSHIP SUBSCRIPTION

- ◆ Graduate Civil Engineers can subscribe to ICEC membership by submitting an application form and paying the prescribed subscription fee.
- ◆ If a member shall permit his/her subscription to remain in arrears for period exceeding one year, his/her membership would be temporarily suspended by default.
- ◆ A suspended member can regain his/her membership by clearing all dues thereto.
